



RST-SANEXAS issues Clarification Regarding DOJ Settlement Resolution

RST-SANEXAS, Inc. is issuing a clarification regarding the Department of Justice press release issued on Dec 16, 2025 concerning a civil settlement the company reached with the government.

The Facts:

Two months ago, the DOJ issued a press release announcing a settlement between RST-SANEXAS and the Department of Justice relating to certain historical marketing and reimbursement practices. The settlement amount is \$1.5 million. RST-SANEXAS did not admit liability and does not agree with all of the government's characterizations of the allegations.

The investigation involved practices related to how the company marketed certain devices and how associated reimbursement claims by physicians were handled. RST-SANEXAS operates solely as a manufacturer, not a clinical provider; accordingly, no insurance claims were submitted by the company. Rather than engage in years of protracted litigation with substantial costs and management distraction, the company determined that settlement represented the most prudent business decision.

What This Settlement Is and Is Not:

Settlement of a government investigation is a legal resolution mechanism - not an admission of guilt, not a judicial finding of wrongdoing, and not evidence that a company's products are unsafe or ineffective. Companies routinely settle government matters despite maintaining strong legal positions, based on cost-benefit analysis of continued litigation.
